CELL PHONES AND OTHER AUDIBLE COMMUNICATION DEVICES POLICY

The Eureka Public Library District recognizes the use of cell phones and other audible communication devices as a necessary part of everyday communication. The library also recognizes that, at times, the use of such devices can interfere with the quality of the library experience for others using library spaces. In order to provide an optimum environment for all our patrons:

Please set cell phones, pagers, and other electronic devices to a non-sounding setting when entering the library building.

Patrons who need to make or take an extended cell phone call should conduct conversations in either the front vestibule (Main Street) or the back vestibule (Parking Lot). Patrons should take their valuable belongings with them when leaving for calls. Inappropriate cell phone use should be reported to a library staff member at the nearest service desk.

Users engaging in disruptive conversations in public and staff areas will be asked by library staff to leave as quickly and quietly as possible.

Please do not speak on communication devices while receiving service at a public service desk.
