When a neighbor that Granny had recently fought with is killed at the orchard, Granny is the obvious suspect. Even with everything else on her plate, Winnie jumps in to find the real murderer in order to clear her Granny's name, and of course clashes with the new handsome sheriff in the process.

This is such a charming book! The depiction of the small town and the orchard during Christmastime is so well done that you feel like you're right there alongside the lovely cast of characters. And the descriptions of the tasty treats and drinks offered by Smythe Orchard made my mouth water, so thankfully there are recipes included in the back of the book! The mystery itself keeps you guessing, with just enough twists and turns to keep you on the edge of your seat.
