Patterson's newest release isn't about Alex Cross, or murder...well, maybe murder enters in from time to time. *E.R. Nurses* is a nonfiction collection of individual stories written by the nurses that run the front line in emergency rooms all across the United States. The stories range from truly bizarre to heartbreaking and hopeful, and, I think it's safe to say for many of these nurses that scenario can happen all in one night.

Patterson and Eversmann spoke with over 50 E.R. nurses who agreed to share parts of their experiences, from small rural hospitals to large emergency rooms in Detroit and New York City. The final segment of the book shares experiences of flight nurses.
