A light and amusing teenage romance for young adults as well as adults. It's the summer before high school senior year and Julieta is at a crossroads. Her family's Argentinian restaurant is on the rocks, she is starting a prestigious summer writing program in NYC led by her favorite author, and there are three boys in her orbit that she is starting to look at differently (and herself by extension). As part of a summer writing assignment, Julieta posts chapters to an online romance story and is shocked when someone by the username HappilyEverDrafter collaborates with her on the story. The person seems to know her, and she can't help but wonder if it is one of the three boys hanging around.

The book follows Julieta's summer as she navigates upheaval in her family's business and changes in relationship dynamics with her friends. Along the way, she discovers what it takes to create the life she most wants heading into her final year of high school and beyond.
