

***The Cryptographer's Dilemma* by Johnnie Alexander**

This novel is one of our newest audiobooks (on CD) in the *Heroines of WWII* series. The six books in this series all have women playing important roles in the events that led up to or that transpired during World War II. In this book, the heroine Eloise Marshall is a cryptographer with the FBI. Her math skills and attention to detail help her solve a mystery that changes the outcome of the war. Eloise's code-breaking skills are put to the test and she is partnered with FBI agent Philip Clayton to find the woman who has been sneaking information about our ships' positions and locations in code to the enemy.

This was an enjoyable read on audio with a good storyline. It is a Christian historical mystery with no bad language or intense scenes. I always like a good spy book that has a happy ending! If you're up to listening, give this one a try.
