The Girls Who Stepped Out of Line is a collection of stories of women who, as the inside cover shares, “Fought for their lives, for their loved ones, and for what was right during World War II.” The stories are the history of women who served as code breakers, spies, and pilots. They smuggled items out, helped with translation of languages, sponsored refugees, and creatively set up necessary housing for immigrants. Retired Major General Eder felt the stories of these 15 extraordinary women needed to be shared and preserved for future generations.
