Historical Christian fiction set during WWII in an Oregon camp of smokejumpers, men parachuting in to the rugged forests to fight wildfires. The group includes many CO's, or conscientious objectors, who face prejudice and hazing because of their objection to all wars, including WW II.

Gordon Hooper and Jack Armitage are buddies who have stuck to their values despite objections of family and friends. As a series of letters show, even romance may be killed off by this basic clash of values involving war and peace.

A member of the WAC's, or Womens Air Corps, Dorie Armitage has been ashamed of her brother's pacifism, but she is now determined to investigate his accident. Arriving at the camp, she pretends to be writing an army report. But now she and Gordon find they must work together for justice, while wrestling with their convictions and the dangerous secrets they discover.
