

*The Love of My Life* by Rosie Walsh

Rosie Walsh's *The Love of My Life* is a standalone novel. Emma is a marine biologist married to Leo. They have a young daughter, Ruby. Emma has completed chemo treatments for lymphoma and she and Leo are anxiously awaiting the results of her most recent PET scan as the story opens. Leo, who works as an obituary writer faces his anxiety in the way he knows best, he secretly begins to write Emma's obituary. However instead of his research being a therapeutic way of facing Emma's mortality, Leo uncovers secrets Emma has kept hidden, including her real name.

As Leo uncovers secrets from Emma's past, he begins to connect with people Emma knew before she knew Leo. Emma and Leo fight for their relationship, even as Leo fights to uncover the whole truth, and Emma finds herself buried in a past she has fought so very hard to leave behind. *The Love of My Life* is designated in reviews as "a thriller," and "full of suspense" but underneath lies a story of love and the commitment one makes to protect those we love.
